- **We are a catalyst for Women against cervical cancer**
 - **We are an international and independent non profit organisation gathering other non profit organisations serving one cause : the fight against cervical cancer**
- **Our mission :**
 - Inform, educate, gather, act together, take common actions
- **We commit to:**
 - Promote information and education on cervical cancer prevention
 - Provide educational material and assist members of the WACC network in their educative role and actions on cervical cancer prevention – with our Task Force
 - Provide bridging among associations and NGOs, from around the world, engaged in the fight against cervical cancer – and encourage best practices and knowledge sharing
 - Welcome all associations and organisations that actively serve our cause and comply to their corresponding regulations - without discrimination and irrespective of race, religion or political affiliations
 - Observe neutrality and impartiality in ways to fight cervical cancer and to educate on the disease and means of protection
 - Independent governance of the WACC foundation is guaranteed by a scientific steering committee, of different international background
 - Engage in transparency regarding our funding and in yearly reporting
 - Respect the EU Charter of Fundamental rights, which first right regards health protection, and the European charter of patient's rights which start with the right to preventive measures.



1. Advocate

- Promote cervical cancer awareness and prevention at local and national political level
- Promote cervical cancer education and prevention through all public health institutions

2. Educate

- Elaborate programs of public education
- Train WACC ambassadors to spread the word on cervical cancer prevention
- Reach out school educators and nurses, relay WACC messages and tools

3. Communicate

- Pitch the media on your concerns, your positions and your actions to educate and prevent cervical cancer
- Organise special events : conferences, march, school challenges, happenings ...where the information can be relayed

4. Interact with other WACC members

- Meet with us (May 2009, Feb. 2010). Participate and give your feedback
- Use available international tools and resources
- Share your best practices, tools and ideas with other members of the global network
- Transfer the WACC newsletter to all your contact database. Submit your story to be published (in English)
- Link your site to www.wacc-network.org

5. Engage in transparency

- Observe compliance with local regulations & ethics
- Inform WACC foundation of actions using WACC tools (contact@wacc-network.org)
- Use of WACC logo as label on your own tools needs acceptance by the foundation or by your local or international WACC Task Force member

- Raise disease awareness in your work place, in your private and family circle
- Raise awareness of prevention and screening benefit for better health protection

- Organise meetings and promote WACC cause in your association, in the schools of your community, in your clubs
- Read and relay WACC tools
